


#### THE GOD WHO STAYS


But somehow You don't see me like I do.



Then he does not scold it because it has caused him so much trouble...

In his joy he takes the trembling creature upon his shoulders; if it is bruised and wounded, he gathers it in his arms, pressing it close to his bosom, that the warmth of his own heart may give it life.
