Revelation 2: 2-5

"I know your works, your labor, your patience, and that you cannot bear those who are evil. And you have tested those who say they are apostles and are not and have found them liars; and you have persevered and have patience and have labored for My name's sake and have not become weary. Nevertheless, I have this against you, that you have left your first love. Remember therefore from where you have fallen; repent and do the first works, or else I will come to you quickly and remove your lampstand from its place unless you repent"

When I claim to be "only human" after giving in to those things I know displeases my Lord.

And you shall love the LORD your God... with all your strength...



When I do not willingly and cheerfully give to God's work or to the needs of others.

1 John 3: 17

"But whoever has this world's goods, and sees his brother in need, and shuts up his heart from him, how does the love of God abide in him?"



When I don't treat other Christians as I would the Lord.

John 13: 34

"A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another; as I have loved you, that you also love one another"



When I see the 10 commandments as a restriction list instead of an expression of His love.

John 14: 21

"He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him"



When I worry more about what the world will think of me instead of the approval of the Lord.

1 John 2: 15

"Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him"



When I fail to share Christ and His word around because I fear rejection.

John 15: 20

"Remember the word that I said to you, "A servant is not greater than his master". If they persecuted Me, they will also persecute you. If they kept My word, they will keep yours also"
