What is a Disciple?

- Mathetes (disciple): Origin in ancient Greece, when a student would attach himself to a teacher for the purpose of acquiring practical and/or theoretical knowledge.
- A disciple is a student, a learner, a follower.
- A spiritual apprentice.



- 1. Submits to the Lordship of Christ
- A disciple puts Christ before family, self, and possessions (Luke 14:26-27, 33)



- 2. Abides in the Teachings of Christ
- A disciple is committed to living according to the teachings of Jesus (John 8:31-32)



- 3. Reveals the Character of Christ
- A disciple bears fruit by abiding in Christ through the Word and prayer (John 15:7-8)



- 4. Reflects the Love of Christ
- A disciple is committed to loving those who are part of the fellowship of believers (John 13:35)




How should we live as disciples?
